GARBAGE & WOODY DEBRIS disposal is available for YACOLT RESIDENTS ONLY.

COST: \$20 per truck load, \$15 car with trailer, \$7 car load.

GARBAGE (Yacolt Residents only - charges apply)

ACCEPTED: Yard and bulky items only.

NOT ACCEPTED: Curbside household & food waste; household hazardous waste (HHW); commercial garbage.

WOODY DEBRIS (Yacolt Residents only - charges apply)

ACCEPTED: Stumps, logs, tree branches, scrap lumber. Please cut logs into sections 4 feet long or less.

NOT ACCEPTED: Grass clippings, leaves.

SCRAP METAL (No charge - open to all)

ACCEPTED: Large appliances (such as stoves, hot water heaters, washers/ dryers, dishwashers), barbecues, metal sinks and similar metal items. Items must be mostly metal.

NOT ACCEPTED: Propane tanks, car bodies, trailers or metals with grease.

Household chemicals, paint, pesticides, poisons and automotive fluids are NOT ACCEPTED AT THIS EVENT -Please see the reverse side for household hazardous waste (HHW) disposal options.

Yacolt Primary School parking lot. 406 W Yacolt Rd: FREE disposal of the materials listed below.

BLOCK FOAM

ACCEPTED: Clean and dry polyurethane. White #6 block foam (Styrofoam*). NOT ACCEPTED: Plastic-wrapped, yellow urethane foam, spongy polypropylene foam, food trays, foam film, hot tub covers, packing peanuts and foam with cardboard with tape or metal attached.

FREON CONTAINING ITEMS

ACCEPTED: Residential freezers, refrigerators and A/C units only; limit three Freon containing units per participant/per day.

NOT ACCEPTED: Commercial equipment or RV and automotive air conditioning units.

ACCEPTED: Computers, monitors, routers, printers, fax machines, typewriters, keyboards, TVs, VCRs, cell phones.


NOT ACCEPTED: Microwaves.

TIRES

ACCEPTED: Regular size automobile, SUV, pickup truck and motorcycle tires without rims; limit five tires per participant/per day. Rims off tires are accepted as scrap metal.

NOT ACCEPTED: Tractor-trailer size or larger, tires with rims, tires from service station owners, repair garages or any type of tire dealer or re-treader.
