Christy Street provided that the project meets setback, placement and all other applicable zoning requirements and provided that Dale and Vicki obtain the appropriate permits from Clark County and furnish the Town with copies of the permits. Motion Carried.

The Clerk/Treasurer advised the Council that Tall Man's Saloon's liquor license is up for renewal. There was a motion by Warren, seconded by Marbut to approve the liquor license renewal for Tall Man's Saloon. Motion Carried.

Mayor Weldon had no comments for the Council.

There was a motion by Mason, seconded by Marbut to approve warrants #9811 through #9836 as follows: Current Expense - \$5,884.58; Fire Department - \$858.77; Parks Department - \$58.85; City Street - \$12,564.81; Cemetery - \$248.29; and Stormwater - \$7,302.24. Motion Carried.
