

March 19, 2007
Council Chambers

The Yacolt Town Council met in regular session on March 19, 2007, at 7:30 p.m. The call to order by Mayor Pro Tem Stewart was followed by the flag salute. Councilmembers present were Madler, Holyk, Marbut, and Weldon. Mayor Warren was absent. There were visitors present.

There was a motion by Marbut, seconded by Holyk to approve the minutes of the March 5, 2007 meeting. Motion Carried.

Two local teenagers were present to inform the Council there is still an interest in developing a skateboard park. A workshop on the matter of developing a skateboard park was scheduled for 7:30 p.m. on Monday, April 23, 2007.

Old Business:

There was a discussion on Ordinance #449. There was a motion by Holyk, seconded by Madler to adopt Ordinance #449 – Establishing And Adopting A Mileage Reimbursement Policy For The Town Of Yacolt. Motion Carried with Councilmember Marbut voting nay.

New Business:

There was a building permit application presented for Jeremy Mark. There was a discussion on the application. There was a motion by Marbut, seconded by Weldon to approve the replacement of rotten flooring and the deteriorating foundation at 511 W. Yacolt Road provided that the project meets setback, placement and all other applicable zoning requirements and provided that Jeremy obtains the appropriate permits from Clark County and furnishes the Town with copies of the permits. Motion Carried.

There was a motion by Weldon, seconded by Marbut to accept the February, 2007 Treasurer's Report as presented. Motion Carried.

Mayor Pro Tem Stewart had no comments for the Council.

There was a motion by Marbut, seconded by Holyk to approve warrants #10727 through #10737 as follows: Current Expense - \$1,020.28; Fire Department - \$132.97; Parks Department - \$75.95; City Street - \$2,213.37; Cemetery - \$7.73; and Stormwater - \$25.00. Motion Carried.

Mayor Pro Tem Stewart declared the meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
