Complete the Survey of Needs of Low-income Families in Clark County

The Survey of Needs of Low-income Families in Clark County asks about needs and concerns you have around several key areas: employment, education, housing, income and asset building, physical health, behavioral health, and support services. It is estimated to take about 15 minutes to complete the survey. The survey is available in English, Spanish, Russian, Ukrainian, and Chuukese.

Who should fill out the survey?

Individuals, couples, and families earning below 200% of the federal poverty level are the primary audience, but anyone who identifies as having a low income or is struggling financially is welcome to complete the survey.

200% of Federal Poverty Level


