

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CERTAIN SECTIONS OF WATER ORDINANCE NO. 181 AND TO REPEAL OTHER ORDINANCES RELATING TO WATER RATES AND COLLECTION:

WHEREAS THE TOWN COUNCIL HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY TO ESTABLISH WATER RATES AND CHARGES AND TO AMEND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE EFFICIENT OPERATION OF THE WATER DEPARTMENT;

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

ORDINANCE NO. 181 PARAGRAPH 11.3.1 SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ:
BILLING PERIOD; METERS SHALL BE READ AND BILLS RENDERED MONTHLY.

SECTION II

ORDINANCE NO. 221 SHALL BE REPEALED AND NO LONGER IN FORCE:

SECTION III

ORDINANCES NO. 198-B; No. 213 AND NO. 223 RELATING TO ADOPTING A SERVICE FEE ON ALL PAST DUE WATER BILLS SHALL BE REPEALED:

THIS SHALL NOW READ; THERE SHALL BE A ONE PERCENT (1%) PER MONTH SERVICE CHARGE ON ALL UNPAID BALANCES OF WATER BILLS OF THIRTY (30) DAYS OR MORE. AFTER FORTY (40) DAYS AND THE BALANCE IS STILL UNPAID, THE WATER SHALL BE TURNED OFF. THERE WILL BE A TEN DOLLAR (10.00) FEE FOR TURNING THE WATER BACK ON.
