

ORDINANCE #542

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING OBSOLETE ORDINANCES

#7, #8, #56, #82, #122, #128, #142, #184, #185, and #289.

Whereas, the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt has deemed it advisable and necessary to codify the Town’s Ordinances, and is therefore preparing to adopt a Yacolt Municipal Code;

Whereas, the Town of Yacolt has identified a number of Ordinances which are no longer useful or valid due to changes in circumstances, or which have been substantially repealed by the enactment of later ordinances, or which have been pre-empted by State law;

Whereas, in preparing Yacolt’s Municipal Code, it is advisable and necessary to exclude those Ordinances which are not or should not any longer be considered effective; and,

Whereas, the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt is in regular session this 20th day of June, 2016, and all members of the Town Council have had notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting:

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington:

Section 1 - Repealer: The following Ordinances are hereby repealed:

- (A). **Ordinance #7:** Ordinance #7 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted November 12, 1908, entitled “An Ordinance Prescribing a Notice and Regulation for Town Election” is hereby repealed.
- (B). **Ordinance #8:** Ordinance #8 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted November 16, 1908, entitled “An Ordinance Providing for the Return and Canvass of the Votes at the City Elections and the Issuing of Election Certificates” is hereby repealed.
- (C). **Ordinance #56:** Ordinance #56 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted June 1, 1914, entitled “An Ordinance Designating a Depository for all Funds Belonging to the Town of Yacolt, Washington, and Providing for a Bond to be Given by Such Depository to Said Town” is hereby repealed.
- (D). **Ordinance #82:** Ordinance #82 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted December 18, 1933, being without an Ordinance title, but relating to “the Establishment of the Various City Funds”, is hereby repealed.
- (E). **Ordinance #122:** Ordinance #122 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted on an unknown date possibly in 1953 or thereafter, entitled “An Ordinance Providing for the Filing of Declarations of Candidacy and the Paying of a

Filing Fee Therefor as the Method for Nominating Candidates for the Annual Municipal General Election, Providing for the Required Filing Dates, and Repealing Ordinance No. 107, all Other Ordinances or Parts Thereof in Conflict Herewith” is hereby repealed.

- (F). **Ordinance #128:** Ordinance #128 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted on an unknown date possibly in 1956 or 1957 or thereafter, entitled “An Ordinance Creating and Establishing a Cumulative Reserve Fund for the Construction, Replacement and Repair of the Water System for the Town of Yacolt, Washington” is hereby repealed.
- (G). **Ordinance #142:** Ordinance #142 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted August 7, 1961, entitled “An Ordinance Creating and Establishing Certain Special Funds Related to the Water Department, Required by the Federal Housing and Home Finance Agency, and a Special Fund Related to the Street Department, Required by the State Division of Municipal Corporations” is hereby repealed.
- (H). **Ordinance #184:** Ordinance #184 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted October 25, 1976, entitled “An Ordinance Creating a Fund in the Treasury of the Town of Yacolt to be Known as the Revenue Sharing Fund” is hereby repealed.
- (I). **Ordinance #185:** Ordinance #185 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted October 25, 1976, entitled “An Ordinance Creating an Ambulance Fund and an Ambulance Reserve Fund” is hereby repealed.
- (J). **Ordinance #289:** Ordinance #289 of the Town of Yacolt, adopted February 17, 1987, entitled “An Ordinance Establishing Agency Fund #601” is hereby repealed.

Section 2 – Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, or its application to any Person or circumstances is held invalid, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, and the application of the provision to other Persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section 3 - Effect of Repeal. The repeal of an ordinance shall not repeal the repealing clause of such ordinance or revive any ordinance which has been repealed thereby.

Section 4 - Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication of the following summary, according to law.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING OBSOLETE ORDINANCES #7, #8, #56, #82, #122, #128, #142, #184, #185, and #289.

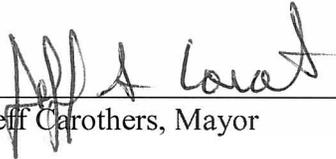
The effective date of the Ordinance is June 29, 2016.

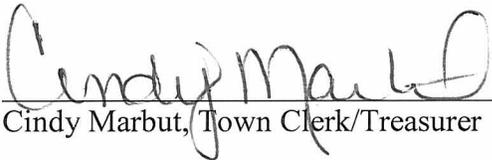

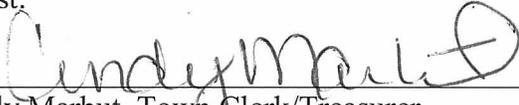
