ORDINANCE #6

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE WIDTH OF SIDEWALKS IN THE TOWN OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON.

Be it ordained by the Council of the town of Yacolt:

Section 1: That the width of sidewalks on all streets in the Town of Yacolt be and the same are hereby established at not less than four feet nor more than eight feet.

Section 2: All sidewalks shall be laid of plank not more than 10 inches wide nor less than 6 inches wide, and not less than two inches in thickness, to be securely spiked with not less than 20 penny nails to three stringers not less than 4x4 inches in size.

Section 3: All sidewalks shall be set out from all property abutting on the streets a distance of six inches.
