## **ORDINANCE 14**

## TO DEFINE AND PREVENT ASSAULT UPON AN OFFICER WIHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF YACOLT AND TO PROVIDE PUNISHMENT THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the council of the Town of Yacolt:

Section 1. If any person knowingly, and willfully resist or oppose any officer of the town of Yacolt or other person authorized by law in serving or attempting to execute any legal work, rule, order or process whatsoever or shall knowingly and willfully resist any such officer in the discharge of his duties without said work, rule order of process, he shall be punished by imprisonment in the town jail not exceeding thirty days or be fined in a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, or both said fine and imprisonment made at the discretion of the court.
