

Ordinance No 20.

Recalled

An ordinance amending ordinance No 12, entitled "To License Tax regulate and restrain the keeping of dogs within the town limits"

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt:

Section 1. That section ⁴ of Ordinance No. 12, entitled "To License regulate and restrain the keeping of dogs within the town limits," adopted Feb. 1 1909, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. It shall be the duty of the marshal or his deputy to seize kill and properly bury in some suitable place outside of the town limits, any and all dogs found running at large in violation of section 1 of this ordinance, also any and all dogs wearing collars running at large on which the owner or representative has failed to pay or renew license; provided that the said owner or representative, when known shall be given ten (10) hours notice for the payment of the amount of the license to the town clerk and a fee of one dollar to the town marshal or other officer who shall have served said notice, for each male dog and a fee of two dollars for each slut or female

dog, and the sum of five dollars for each slut in heat.
