Ordinance No 23.

An ordinance to prevent  
 the injury or obstruction  
 of streets in the town  
 of Yacolt, Washington, and  
 providing a penalty for  
 the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the  
 Council of the town of  
 Yacolt:

Section 1. That any persons  
 who as principal, <sup>agent</sup> or otherwise,  
 either by placing matter upon  
 the surface or by displacing  
 the soil, shall obstruct in any  
 way or manner the public  
 streets of the town of Yacolt,  
 Washington in such a manner  
 as to prevent or hinder the  
 enjoyment thereof for the purposes  
 for which they were designed or  
 in such a manner as to tend  
 to obscure the exclusive right  
 of said town to the same for  
 public purposes, without first  
 obtaining permission from  
 the street committee to do so,  
 shall be deemed guilty of a  
 breach of ordinance, and upon  
 conviction thereof before the  
 town justice of the peace may  
 be fined in any sum not to  
 exceed One Hundred dollars  
 and costs of prosecution

Ordinance No. 24.

An ordinance to advertise  
for bids for the construction  
of a Municipal water plant  
for the town of Yacolt in  
accordance with the plans  
and specifications adopted  
therefor by ordinance No 21  
and to authorize the sale of  
the bonds in the sum of  
5800<sup>00</sup> to partly pay for the same  
under and by the authority of  
the vote of the citizens of the  
town at election held September  
14, 1910.

Be it ordained by the council  
of the Town of Yacolt:  
1st: That the council proceed  
to the construction of a mun-  
icipal water system known  
as the Big Creek Gravity Water System  
in accordance with the plans  
and specifications on file with  
the town clerk and adopted by  
the council in Ordinance No 21.

2nd That A. D. Monteth, the  
City Engineer employed for the  
construction of <sup>the</sup> said water  
plant and water system for  
the town in accordance  
with the plans and specifications  
now on file, now therefore, completing  
the same with necessary detail  
for such purpose; such bids  
to be received either in one bid  
for the construction of the entire
