Ordinance No. 24.

An ordinance to advertise
for bids for the construction
of a Municipal water plant
for the town of Yacolt in
accordance with the plans
and specifications adopted
therefor by ordinance No 21
and to authorize the sale of
the bonds in the sum of
5800⁰⁰ to partly pay for the same
under and by the authority of
the vote of the citizens of the
town at election held September
14, 1910.

Be it ordained by the council
of the Town of Yacolt:
1st: That the council proceed
to the construction of a mun-
icipal water system known
as the Big Creek Gravity Water System
in accordance with the plans
and specifications on file with
the town clerk and adopted by
the council in Ordinance No 21.

2nd That A. D. Monteth, the
City Engineer employed for the
construction of ^{the} said water
plant and water system for
the town in accordance
with the plans and specifications
now on file, now therefore, completing
the same with necessary detail
for such purpose; such bids
to be received either in one bid
for the construction of the entire

system or in sessions thereof as in his judgment and that of a committee of the council appointed for the purpose of advising the engineer in the matter; said bids to be submitted to the council for its approval or rejection on the 10th Day of October, 1910 at 8³⁰ P.M. or at ~~any~~ ^{such} other time or times as the Council may determine when the bids may be received; provided, always the total sums bid shall not exceed in the aggregate the sum of \$10223⁰⁰.

3rd That the town Clerk proceed to prepare the bond provided for by ~~the~~ ordinance No 21 and therein described, the issuance and sale of which is authorized by vote of citizens at special election held by the town September 14, 1910 and advertise for bids for the purchase of the same according to the terms of said ordinance No 21 for a period of thirteen days in the following newspapers: to-wit:

"The Yaquina Bulletin" one issue
 "The Portland Daily Abstract" three times at intervals and
 "The Pacific Engineer and Builder" one issue.

all bids for the purchase of said bonds shall be reported

to the ^{Town} Council on the 3rd Day of October, 1910 at 8:30 o'clock P.M. for approval or rejection.
