

Ordinance No 26

An ordinance establishing width of sidewalks upon Jones Street in the town of Yacolt, Clarke County, Washington, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Yacolt,

Section 1.

That from and after the passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to lay, build or construct any sidewalk or sidewalks upon Jones Street in the town of Yacolt, Clarke Co., Washington, except such sidewalk or sidewalks be six feet in width and of plank not more than six inches wide, said plank to be two inches in thickness and to be securely spiked with four inch spikes (not less than five such spikes to each board) to stringers not less than 4 x 4 inches in size

Section 2-

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction before the Police Justice shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars

or by imprisonment in the town jail not less than five (5) days nor more than thirty (30) days, and any person who shall maintain or continue such violation after conviction of the first offense shall for each day of maintaining or continuing be deemed guilty of a separate offense and on conviction thereof shall be punished to the full ^{extent} of the fine or imprisonment provided in this section.

Section 3.

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval by the mayor, and publication according to law.

Ordinance No 27

An ordinance granting to C.R. Miller, his heirs, administrators, and assigns, the right and privilege to the use of the dam at "Big Creek Falls" proposed to be constructed by the town of Yacolt (provided the same shall be constructed by said town) for the connection with the said dam and water stored therein and maintenance thereof. A pipe line to convey water to a powerhouse owned by the said C.R. Miller and used for electric light generation near the dam, all at the expense of the said C.R. Miller, his heirs, administrators, and assigns, said water to be used to furnish power to generate electricity to be used in lighting the streets of the town of Yacolt, Washington, and furnishing heat, light and power to the citizens thereof.

Be it ordained by the Council of the town of Yacolt

Section 1.

That C.R. Miller, his heirs administrators and assigns are hereby granted the right
