

## Ordinance No. 29.

An ordinance in relation to licenses, Shooting galleries to be licensed for the operation thereof.

Be it ordained by the town council of Yacolt, as follows to-wit:-

Section 1 That License, which by law the town of Yacolt is authorized to grant and also those which are provided for by this ordinance, shall be issued by the town clerk on presentation of a receipt from the town treasurer showing that the license tax imposed by ordinance has been paid.

Section 2-- Shooting galleries within the incorporated limits of the town of Yacolt shall pay a license of \$5<sup>00</sup> per Quarter.

Section 3-- It shall be the duty of the town Marshall to demand the payment of all licenses herein enumerated and provided for and whenever it shall come to his knowledge that provisions of this ordinance have been violated within the said limits to forthwith make complaint in writing before the police justice of the town accusing the party or parties

violating the same therewith

Section 6= If any person or persons exercise or carry on any trade or do any act by which a license is required by this ordinance, without taking out such license, as in that behalf required by this ordinance, he, she, or they shall, on conviction thereof before the chief justice of the town of Yacolt, for every such offense, besides being liable for the amount of the license tax be subjected to imprisonment in the town jail for a term not exceeding 5 days or a fine not exceeding \$10<sup>00</sup> or both at the discretion of the court.

Section 7= This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage by the town Council, approval by the mayor and publication according to law
