~~An ordinance empowering the Mayor of the town of Yacolt to appoint an attorney, pound-master, a Superintendent of streets, civil engineer, a health officer, marshal, Clerk, report of such appointments to the Council for approval; fixing the salaries and compensations of such as are to receive salaries; Designating the "Yacolt Bulletin" as the official paper of the city, and providing the compensation to be received by such paper for official notices and publications by the town of Yacolt; and other regulations of all of the said officers.~~

~~Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt as follows, to-wit:~~

~~First:- That the mayor of the Town of Yacolt shall annually at the first regular meeting of the Town Council in the month of January in each year appoint the following officers to-wit:-~~

~~A marshal, Clerk, attorney, pound-master, Superintendent of Streets, Civil Engineer, police Justice, necessary Police officers and a health officer, the~~

appointment of all said officers to be approved by the council.

Second: Any vacancies occurring in any of the offices provided for in Section 1, shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, such appointment to be duly reported to the council at the next meeting of the same, for approval.

Third: all of the officers mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance, shall receive such compensation for their services as such officers, as may be determined by the Council at its first regular meeting in January in each year, provided always that the Council will keep intact any contract for a definite time already made.

Fourth: The following mentioned officers shall receive for their services during the year 1911, the following named amounts, to-wit:

The Clerk the sum of \$10<sup>00</sup> per month  
 The Marshall the sum of 30<sup>00</sup> per month  
 The said Attorney the sum of \$12<sup>50</sup> per month and travelling expenses to Yacolt when called

by the City; The Engineer the sum of \$ — per month. The Health officer the sum of \$ — per month; The Poundmaster the sum of \$ — per month; The Superintendent of streets the sum of \$ — per month and the City Police Justice the sum of \$ — per trial

Fifth: The "Yacolt Bulletin" is designated and hereby made the official paper of the Town of Yacolt, for a period of one year, for the publication of all official notices, ordinances, contracts, and other official papers necessary to be published; the compensation to be received by the said paper for all such publications is as follows, to-wit:  
 — 35<sup>00</sup> per inch -- 8 point Basis.

Sixth: The Health officer shall not incur any expense in the caring for sick and in his performance of duty as such Health officer, chargeable to the Town of Yacolt, without first having an order to take care of such sick or injured person, and having been previously empowered by the

Mayor to so care for such person and make such expenditures.

Seventh: Ordinances numbered nine and thirteen heretofore passed by the Council of Yacolt are hereby repealed.

Eighth: This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.

Ordinance No 31.

An ordinance to regulate the management of the water works of the Town of Yacolt, Specify the price to be charged, designate the collector of water rents and the proper committee of the Council to handle the business and other particulars regarding the government of the water system of Yacolt, Washington

Be it ordained by the Council of the town of Yacolt:

Section I Applications for the use of water must be made on printed forms to be furnished at the office of the treasurer, and the applicant must state fully and truly all the purposes for which the water may be required, and must agree to conform to the rules and regulations, as a condition for the use of the water.

Section II No person supplied with water from the city mains will be entitled to use it for any purposes other than stated in his or her application, or to supply in any way other persons or families
