Ordinance No. 35.

An Ordinance providing for the improvement of Cushman Street in the town of Yakalt, Clarke County, Washington by grading said Cushman Street from the East Line of West Railroad Street Westerly to the East line of Ambay Street, and providing for a special assessment therefor on the property specially benefited thereby.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yakalt, Washington:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby established an improvement district within the limits of the Town of Yakalt to be called the Local Improvement District No. 1 which shall be bounded by the following description, to-wit:

Beginning at a point where the center of Cushman Street intersects the East line of West Railroad Street, thence South easterly along the East line of West Railroad Street to a point 135 feet due South from the South line of Cushman Street. Thence Westerly through the middle of blocks one (1) and two (2), of the first addition to Yakalt,

to the East line of Parcell Street; thence Northerly to the ^{North} line of Cushman Street; thence Westerly along the South line of Block one (1) third (3^d) addition to the Town of Yakalt, to the Southwest corner thereof; thence North 135 feet along the East line of Ambay Street to the middle of the West line of said Block one (1) third (3^d) addition; thence Easterly through the center of said block one (1) third (3^d) addition to Yakalt and through the center of the original town of Yakalt to the East line of said West Railroad Street; thence South easterly to the place of beginning.

Said Cushman Street shall be improved by grading of the said Street between the points described as follows: The East line of West Railroad Street and the East line of Ambay Street.

Section 2 Such improvements shall be made and expenses thereof including the costs of surveying, advertisements, superintendents, etc shall be taxed and assessed upon all of the property in said improvement district, which

Costs shall be assessed upon all of the property in said improvement district in accordance with the number of feet of such lots and lands fronting thereon and included within the said improvement district and in proportion to the benefits derived from such improvements. Such improvements shall be made in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor now on file in the office of the Town Clerk of said Town of Yakolt, Washington.

Section III This ordinance shall be in force ^{within five days} from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the mayor and publication according to law.
