Ordinance No 36.

An Ordinance providing for the improvement of Parcel Street in the town of Yacolt, Clarke County, Washington, for grading said Parcel Street from the South line of Yacolt Road Street to the North line of Cushman Street and providing for a special assessment therefor on the property specially benefited thereby.

Be it ordained by the Town of Yacolt, Washington:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby established an Improvement District within the limits of the town of Yacolt, Clarke County, Washington, which shall be bounded by the following mentioned lines and shall embrace all the property included in the following description, to-wit:

Beginning at a point where the center of Parcel Street intersects the South Line of Yacolt Road Street thence East 100 feet to the North East Corner of Lot 6 original Town of Yacolt, Thence South

270 to the South East Corner of Lot 9, old town of Yacolt; thence west on the north line of Cushman Street to the South West corner of Lot 11, block 1 3rd addition to Yacolt thence north to the Northwest corner of Lot 2 of block 1 of the third addition to Yacolt, thence easterly along the South line of Yacolt Road St. to the place of beginning.

Section 2 Said Parcel St. shall be improved by grading of the same in accordance with plans and specifications therefor now on file in the office of the town clerk of said Town of Yacolt, Washington

Section 3. Such improvements shall be made and the cost and expense thereof shall be taxed and assessed upon all of the property in said Improvement District which cost shall be assessed in accordance with the number of feet of such lots and lands fronting thereon and included within said improvement district, and in proportion to the benefits derived from such improvements

and said cost of improvement shall include all expenses of surveying, advertising, superintendents, etc.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force within five days from and after its passage by the Council approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
