Ordinance No 40

An Ordinance of
the Town of Yacolt, Wash-
ington, providing for the
repeal of Ordinances Nos.
35, 36 and 37 and providing
for the annulment of all
resolutions, motions or
other proceedings relation
to or affecting the proposed
improvement of the streets
described in this ordinance.
Be it ordained by
the town of Yacolt, Wash-
ington:

Section I That ord-
inances Nos 35, 36 and 37
and all motions, resolutions
or other proceedings had
or done relation to or
affecting the proposed im-
provement of the hereafter
described streets prior to
June 17, 1912 are hereby con-
sidered repealed and
annulled.

The streets referred to are
described as follows:

Commencing at
the intersection of the
Ambay road and the Yacolt
Road street, thence east
to West Railroad street; thence
southeast on West Railroad
street to Cushman street;

thence west to Parcel St;
thence north to Yakov Road
street also the north half
of Cushman from Parcel
Street to Aubrey Street

This ordinance shall
be in full force and effect
from and after its passage
by the council, approval by
the mayor and posting or
publishing as provided
by law

Ordinance No 41.

An Ordinance of the
Town of Yakov, Washington
prohibiting the riding or driving
of animals, bicycles, motorcycles
or other motor vehicles upon
any of the board or hard-
^{surface} surfaced sidewalks, ^{or upon any of the board or} to be
hereafter constructed within the
incorporated limits of the Town
of Yakov.

Be it Ordained by the
Town Council of Yakov,
Washington:

Section I It shall be
unlawful for any person to
ride or drive any horse or
other animal, or any bicycle,
motorcycle or other motor
vehicle upon any of the
board or hard-surfaced
sidewalks within the
incorporated limits of
Yakov, or upon any of
the board or hard surfaced
sidewalks to be hereafter
constructed within the limits
of the said town.

Section II Any person
violating any of the
provisions of this ordinance
shall upon conviction thereof
be punished by a fine of
not less than \$1.00 nor more.
