Section III This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publishing as required by law.

An Ordinance of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, providing for the improvement of Parcel Street, Yacolt Road Street, West Railroad Street, and Cushman Street, as hereinafter definitely described and providing a local improvement district in accordance with Resolution No 1 of said Town of Yacolt, and providing that payment for said improvement may be made by special assessment upon the property in said district.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That there is hereby established and created local improvement District within the limits of the Town of Yacolt, to be called Local Improvement District Number 1, which shall include and be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point where the center line ^{of Cushman Street} intersects the center line of the Northern Pacific right-of-way

Thence south-easterly along the center line of the Northern Pacific Right-of-way to a point 135 feet due south ~~of~~ from the South line of Cushman Street; thence westerly through the middle of Blocks one (1) and two (2) of the first addition to Yakalt to the east line of Parcel Street; Thence northerly to the North line of Cushman Street; Thence westerly along the South line of Block one (1), third addition to Yakalt to the Southwest Corner thereof; thence due North to the Northwest of ^{said} Block One (1) third addition. Thence Easterly to a point where the west line of block 5, Twin Falls addition to Yakalt intersects the South line of Yakalt Road Street Thence due north to the Center line of Block 5, Twin Falls Addition about 160 feet; thence due East to a point of intersection of the center line of Block 5 Twin Falls addition with the center line of the Northern Pacific Right-of-way. Thence south-easterly along said line to point of beginning.

Section 2. The grades of the streets within this district shall be according to the profile on file with the city clerk, such parts as are above grade shall be

excavated and such parts as are below grade shall be filled to conform with said profile and the plans and specifications for grading said streets, which are now on file in the office of the town clerk.

Section 3. The said streets shall be improved by grading and macadamizing and constructing curbs and drains and such other work done as may be necessary in connection therewith according to the Plans and Specifications, therefor, prepared under the direction of the city engineer and on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

Section 4. The cost of this improvement including all necessary incidental expenses, shall be borne and assessed against the property included in the assessment hereby created in this Ordinance. The Town of Yakalt shall not be liable in any manner for any portion of the costs and expenses of said improvement except the costs and expenses of

Street intersections

Section 5-- This improvement shall be upon the immediate plan and all assessments hereby levied shall be due and payable to the city treasurer, Thirty days after the passage of this Ordinance.

Section 6--- This ordinance shall take effect after its passage and ^{after 5 days} publication, as provided by law.
