

An Ordinance of the town of Yacolt, Washington regulating the attendance of members of the Town Council, and providing a penalty for the failure on the part of any council member to attend the regular meetings of the Town Council.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington.

Section 1 That all council meetings shall be held at the Masonic Hall, in the Town of Yacolt.

Section 2 That all members shall attend the meetings of the Council regularly and in case that any member of the council is absent from meetings for three consecutive regular meetings without having received permission from the council, his office shall be declared vacant by the council, and a new councilman shall be appointed or elected by a majority of the said remaining council.

Section 3

This ordinance shall be in full force and virtue and effect from and after its passage by the mayor and ^{posting or} publishing as by law provided.
