

Ordinance No 44

An Ordinance of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, prohibiting the jumping on or off or otherwise interfering with or molesting or riding upon, except as herein excepted, any engine, passenger car, log train, or other railway vehicle used by any railroad company in the town of Yacolt, Washington, within the town limits of ^{the town} of Yacolt, Wash., and providing a penalty for the violation of this Ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Town of Yacolt, Washington:

Section I

It shall be unlawful for any person, not an employee of said railway company in the actual work of operating its trains, to jump upon or off from or to ride upon or interfere with or otherwise molest, any train, engine or other railway vehicle, within the town limits of Yacolt, or to in any manner bother around or jump upon trains.

Nothing in this ordinance shall be interpreted to interfere with the right of passengers or employees of railway com-

panies.

Section II

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$3000, or by imprisonment in the city jail not more than 30 days or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section III

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting ~~and~~ publishing as required by law.

An ordinance empowering the mayor of Yacalt to appoint an attorney, poundmaster, a superintendent of streets, police justice, police officers, a health officer, marshal and clerk; to report such appointments of said officers to the town council; to fix the salaries and compensations of such officers as are to receive salaries or compensations; to provide for bonds for all or any of said appointed or elective officers; and to provide any other regulations of all or any of the said officers as may be deemed necessary by the Mayor and Council, and to repeal Ordinance No 30, passed by the Town Council March 6, 1911

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacalt as follows: to-wit:

First: That the mayor of the Town of Yacalt shall appoint the following officers for said town, to-wit: An Attorney, Poundmaster, Superintendent of Streets, a civil engineer and such police and other subordinate officers deemed necessary.
