Repealed

An ordinance empowering the mayor of Yacalt to appoint an attorney, poundmaster, a superintendent of streets, police justice, police officers, a health officer, marshal and clerk; to report such appointments of said officers to the town council; to fix the salaries and compensations of such officers as are to receive salaries or compensations; to provide for bonds for all or any of said appointed or elective officers; and to provide any other regulations of all or any of the said officers as may be deemed necessary by the Mayor and Council, and to repeal Ordinance No 30, passed by the Town Council March 6, 1911

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacalt as follows: to-wit:

First: That the mayor of the Town of Yacalt shall appoint the following officers for said town, to-wit: An Attorney, Poundmaster, Superintendent of Streets, a civil engineer and such police and other subordinate officers deemed necessary.

Second: Any vacancies occurring in any of the offices provided for in Section I, occurring either by death, resignation or removal by the Mayor, shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, such appointment to be duly reported to the Council at the next meeting of the same,

Third: All of the officers mentioned in section 1. of this ordinance shall receive such compensation for their services as such officers as may be determined by the Council, in this Ordinance hereinafter mentioned, provided always that the Council shall keep intact any contract for a definite time already made.

Fourth: The following mentioned officers shall receive for their services the following named amounts: to wit:

The Clerk the sum of \$10⁰⁰ per month

The Marshall the sum of \$60⁰⁰ per month

The Attorney the sum of \$

per month

The Civil Engineer the sum of \$ — per month

The Health Officer the sum of \$ — per month

The Poundmaster the sum of \$ — per month

The Superintendent of Streets the sum of \$ — per month

The Police Justice the sum of \$2⁰⁰ per trial

Fifth: The following mentioned Officers before beginning the performance of their duties, shall enter into a Surety Bond to the Town of Yacolt for the proper performance of their duties the expense of said Surety Bond to be paid out of the Current Expense fund of the Town of Yacolt, as follows, to wit:

The Treasurer in the sum of \$4000⁰⁰

The Clerk in the sum of \$1000⁰⁰

The Marshall in the sum of \$100000

The Attorney in the sum of \$ _____

The Civil Engineer in the sum of \$ _____

The Health Officer in the sum of \$ _____

The Paupermaster in the sum of \$ _____

The Superintendent ^{of streets} in the sum of \$ _____

The Police Justice in the sum of \$100000

Sixth: The Health Officer shall not incur any expense in the caring for sick and in his performance as such health officer, chargeable to the Town of Yacolt, without first having an order to take care of such sick or injured person, and having ^{been} previously empowered by the Mayor to so care for such person and make such expenditures.

Seventh: Ordinance No 30,

passed by the Town Council March 6, 1911 is hereby repealed

Eighth: This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage by the Town Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
