Ordinance No. 47.

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No 16 entitled "an ordinance in relation to Licenses and punishment for the violation of the terms thereof."

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt:

Section 1 That section 3 of Ordinance No 16, of the Ordinances of the Town of Yacolt, entitled "An Ordinance in relation to Licenses and punishment for the violation of the terms thereof," adopted on the 9th day of June, 1909, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. All peddlars and hawkers shall, before entering upon their business obtain a license by paying to the Town Treasurer: Three (3) Dollars per day for each pack peddler, seven (7) Dollars per day for each peddler with one horse and wagon, and Ten (10) Dollars per day for each peddler with two horses and wagon. Any person who offers goods by outcry on the streets, alleys or public squares or shall conduct business from a stand

or any vehicle anywhere within the Town Limits, shall be deemed a hawk; and all persons except those peddling newspapers, Bibles and religious tracts, who go from house to house or from place to place in the town selling at retail any goods, wares, mer- chandise, books, pictures, maps or any other commodity, shall be regarded as peddlars under this Ordinance; provided, however, this section shall not apply to farmers or other persons peddling the products of their own farms, gardens or milk ranches.

Read 1st and second times July 7, 1913.

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. #15, entitled "To Define Nuisances, to provide for the abatement thereof and the punishment of those who allow or maintain them"

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt:

Section I That section 6 of Ordinance Number 15, of the Ordinances of the Town of Yacolt, entitled "To Define Nuisances, to Provide for the Abatement thereof and the Punishment of those who allow or maintain them" adapted June 9, 1909, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6 No person or persons shall keep or maintain within the corporate limits of the town of Yacolt any outhouse, barn, stable, cow shed, poultry yard, or manure pile in such a manner as to cause a noisome or offensive smell, and no person or persons shall keep or maintain any pig sty or pig pen within the fol- lowing described boundaries, to wit:

Commencing at the
