

or any vehicle anywhere within the Town Limits, shall be deemed a hawk; and all persons except those peddling newspapers, Bibles and religious tracts, who go from house to house or from place to place in the town selling or retail any goods, wares, mer- chandise, books, pictures, maps or any other commodity, shall be regarded as peddlars under this Ordinance; provided, however, this section shall not apply to farmers or other persons peddling the products of their own farms, gardens or milk ranches.

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. #15, entitled "To Define Nuisances, to provide for the abatement thereof and the punishment of those who allow or maintain them"

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt:

Section I That section 6 of Ordinance Number 15, of the Ordinances of the Town of Yacolt, entitled "To Define Nuisances, to Provide for the Abatement thereof and the Punishment of those who allow or maintain them" adapted June 9, 1909, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6 No person or persons shall keep or maintain within the corporate limits of the town of Yacolt any outhouse, barn, stable, cow shed, poultry yard, or manure pile in such a manner as to cause a noisome or offensive smell, and no person or persons shall keep or maintain any pig sty or pig pen within the fol- lowing described boundaries, to wit:

Commencing at the

Northwest corner of Acre Lot 10 of Landon's Yacalt Acre tract, running thence south along the East Line of Hubbard Street to the Southwest corner of Acre Lot 30, of the addition to Yacalt Acre Lots, Thence due East to the North East Corner of Lot 1, Wilson's addition, Thence Southeastly to the Southeast corner of Lot 13, Block 5 Wilson's addition, thence due west along the North Line of Yacalt Avenue to the Southeast corner of Lot 12, Block 4, Fourth addition to the Town of Yacalt, Thence North along the East Line of Parcell Street to the Southwest corner of Lot 12, Block 2, Fourth addition to the Town of Yacalt, Thence West to the Southwest corner of Lot 7, Block 2, Fourth addition to the Town of Yacalt; Thence North to the intersection of the South Line of Cushman Street; Thence due West to the <sup>intersection of</sup> East Line of Johnson Street; Thence North along said East Line of Johnson Street to the South Line of Yacalt Road Street; Thence Eastly to a Point where the South Line of Yacalt Road Street intersects the West Line of Block 5, Twin Falls addition to Yacalt; Thence North along the said

West Line of Block 5, Twin Falls addition to the Town of Yacalt to the North-west Corner of Lot 8, Block 5, Twin Falls addition to the Northeast of Lot 1, Block 4, Twin Falls addition, Thence South <sup>to</sup> the South East corner of said Block 4, Twin Falls addition, thence Southeastly to the point of beginning.

Nothing in this section shall be construed so as to permit any person or persons to keep or maintain or to allow to be kept or maintained any pig-sty or pig-pen in a filthy condition so as to cause a noisome or offensive smell anywhere within the limits of the Town of Yacalt, whether outside of the herein described boundaries or not.

Ordinance No. 49

An Ordinance to protect the purity of the Water Supply of the Town of Yacolt, Washington; De-fining offenses against such Purity, and providing a penalty for the Violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt;

Section 1.

No Person, firm or Corporation shall throw, place or deposit or cause to be thrown, placed or deposited any dung, carrion, dead animal, offal, or putrid or unwholesome substance or filth of any kind, or any rubbish of any kind or the contents of any privy in, upon or near any stream, lake, spring, river, creek, tributary or pond from which the Town of Yacolt, Washington derives its water supply, nor upon the area draining into such stream, lake, spring, river, creek, tributary or pond.
