

An Ordinance regulating the operation of railroad trains, locomotives and cars within the corporate limits of the town of Yacalt and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacalt:

Sec I. It shall be unlawful for any person firm or corporation, within the corporate limits of the Town of Yacalt, Washington, to operate or cause to be operated, any railroad train, railroad locomotive or railroad car, over across or upon any public street, highway or road crossing at a greater rate of speed than 8 miles per hour.

Sec II. That no person, firm or corporation shall, within said corporate limits, run or cause to be run, any railroad car or cars across any public street, highway or road crossing, unless a locomotive is attached to such car or cars.

Sec III. That no person, firm

or corporation shall, within said corporate limits, cause to back ~~up~~ to or across any public street, highway or road crossing, any railroad locomotive, or railroad car or cars, unless there be stationed at the intersection of such public street, highway or road crossing upon which such locomotive, car or cars are being operated, a brakeman or other person to warn the general public of the approach of such locomotive or car or cars.

Sec. IV. That no person, firm or corporation shall, within said corporate limits, make what is known as a "flying switch", "drop switch", or other equally dangerous switch, across any public street, highway or road crossing.

Sec V. Any firm, person or corporation violating this ordinance, upon conviction before a police justice of the town of Yacalt shall be punished by fines in any amount not exceeding the sum of One Hundred (100) Dollars or by imprisonment in the town

jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section VI This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval by the Mayor and its publication according to law.

Sec VII All existing ordinances and parts of ordinances of the town of Yazoo in conflict with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.
