Being an Ordinance Amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 16 entitled "An Ordinance in relation to licenses and punishment for the violation thereof"

The Town Council of the Town of Yacolt do ordain as follows; that section (2) of said ordinance be amended and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: To-wit:

Sec. 2 The owner of any Stage, carriage, coach, Hack, Dray, Cart or wagon, or other vehicle which shall be used for the conveyance of Passengers, Packages, Goods, or Freight of any kind within the Town Limits, for hire, except hand carts and vehicles used by merchants, dealers and manufacturers, exclusively for the delivery of their own wares to their customers, and vehicles of Livery stables and Hotels shall pay an annual license as follows, to-wit:

All vehicles drawn by one horse the sum of \$10.00 for each calendar year.

All vehicles drawn by two or

more horses the sum of \$20.00 for each Calendar year, for each vehicle so used

The owner or keeper of such vehicle licensed shall provide a metal plate three inches wide and six inches long upon which shall be printed in conspicuous figures the number of the License issued therefore and said plate shall be affixed to said vehicle licensed in some conspicuous place thereon.

This amendment shall be in full force and effect immediately after its acceptance by the Council, approval by the mayor and published according to law.

An Ordinance prohibiting certain animals and fowls from running at large within the limits of the Town of Yakolt, Washington, providing for the impounding and sale of such animals or fowls, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Town of Yakolt as follows:

Section I It shall be unlawful for the owner of any horses, mules, cattle, sheep, swine, goats, geese, ducks, chickens or other fowls to permit the same to run at large within the limits of the Town of Yakolt or to stake, tie or herd same on any street in the town or on premises of which the owner of such horse, mule, sheep, swine, goats, geese or ducks is not the owner or entitled to the possession.
