

An Ordinance prescribing and defining certain duties of ^{marshals} Police Justice of the Town of Yacolt

Be it ordained by the Council of the town of Yacolt Clarke County, Washington:

Section I The Marshall shall make a report in writing, duly verified, to the Town Council at its first regular meeting in each month, covering the following items;

"Monthly report of Town Marshall of the town of Yacolt for the preceding month of 191

Number of arrests, and upon what charges

Number of Prisoners confined in the Jail during the month

Number of days labor performed by prisoners upon streets or other public property or works, during the month

Number of meals furnished

prisoners during the month.

Cost of meals and by whom furnished

The amount of any and all License or Tax monies coming into his hands during the month."

Section II The Marshall shall on or before the first Monday of each month, pay over to the Town Treasurer, all monies received or collected during the preceding month taking the said Treasurer's receipt for the same in duplicate, the original to be retained by the said Marshall and the duplicate filed by him with the Town Clerk

Section 3. The Town Justice of the Peace, shall at the first regular meeting of the Council each month, report to and file duly verified transcripts of all cases tried and disposed of by him during the preceding month; said transcripts to show the amount of Fine and Costs imposed

in each individual case or term of Commitment issued, and the amount of fines and costs collected in cash.

Section 4.

The said Justice of the Peace, shall on or before the first Monday of each month, pay over to the Town Treasurer all monies collected by him during the month preceeding from fines, costs or otherwise, taking the said Treasurer's receipt in duplicate therefor the original to be retained by the said Justice and the duplicate by him filed with the Town Clerk.

Section 5.

No salary, warrant or other compensation shall be paid to the Marshall or Justice of the Peace, until the said receipts and reports as are herein ~~mentioned~~ indicated and required of each of said officer monthly are duly made and filed with and approved by the Town Council; and in case of failure to so report for two successive months by either of said officers the Town Council may demand and require the same from

the Bondsman or sureties of the said officers

Section 6.

The Town Clerk shall furnish to the said Marshall and Justice of the Peace the necessary blanks for said reports
