Ordinance No 57

An Ordinance providing for the improvement of Yacolt Road Street in the town of Yacolt, Clarke County, Washington, by grading said Yacolt Road Street from the center line of the Northern Pacific Railway Company, East to the West Line of Hubbard Street in said town and by placing wooden sidewalks and curbs on each side of said Yacolt Road Street between said points.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington.

Section I That there be and is hereby established an improvement district within the limits of the town of Yacolt, Clarke County, Washington, to be called Local Improvement District No. 3, which shall be bounded by the following mentioned lines and shall embrace all the property included in the following description, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Block one in Second addition to Yacolt, Washington, running

thence north along the west line of Hubbard street in said town to the center of the East line of Block Four in Twin Falls Addition to ~~the~~ said town; thence west, parallel with the north line Yacolt Road Street in said town, to a point due north of the point of intersection of the middle line of said Yacolt Road Street with the center line of the Northern Pacific Railway Company; thence south to a point due west of the center of the west line of Block Two in said second addition; and thence east to the place of beginning.

Section II Said Yacolt Road Street shall be improved by grading the same and placing on each side thereof wooden sidewalks and curbs between the center line of the Northern Pacific Railway Company and the west line of Hubbard Street, all in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, now on file in the office of the town Clerk of said town of

Yacolt, Washington.

Section III Such improvement shall be made and the cost and expense thereof shall be taxed and assessed upon all of the property in said improvement district, which cost shall be assessed in accordance with the number of feet of such lot and lands fronting thereon and included within the said improvement district and in proportion to the benefits derived from such improvement with the exception of the expenses of surveying, advertising, superintendence and intersections which shall be paid for by the town of Yacolt.

Section IV This ordinance shall be in force within five days after its passage by the Council, approval by the mayor and publication according to law.
