

An Ordinance amending Section 4 of Ordinance No. 5 entitled "To regulate and license the sale and disposal of Spirituous, fermented and all other intoxicating liquors within the corporate limits of the town of Yacolt and to prohibit such sale without license and provide a penalty therefor"

Be it ordained by the Council of <sup>the Town of</sup> Yacolt as follows:

Section I That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 5 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 4. Any person or firm desiring a license for the sale and disposal of any spirituous, fermented, or malt, or other intoxicating liquors within the corporate limits of the Town of Yacolt, shall present to the Council at a regular meeting a petition in writing signed by the applicant and designating the building or place in which the business is to be carried on; the applicant shall at the same time present to the Council a bond in the sum of One Thousand Dollars conditioned that the applicant shall keep an orderly house and will not sell

liquors to minors, which bond must be signed by one or more sureties and approved by the Mayor and accepted by the Council, and in case a license be granted to the applicant, he shall on making payment to the Town Treasurer of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars, be entitled to a license for One year, unless the same shall sooner be declared forfeited by the Council for a violation of the terms on which it was granted; provided, however, that a license may be granted for a less period than one year upon the advance payment of a license fee for as many  $365^{\text{ths}}$  of a year as there are days covered by the application

Section II This amendment shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.

An Ordinance providing for the improvement of West Railroad Street in the town of Yacolt, Clarke County, Washington, by grading and macadamizing said West Railroad Street from the South line of Cushman Street to the South limits of the Town of Yacolt in said town and by placing wooden sidewalks and curbs on the west side of West Railroad Street between Cushman and Jones Streets

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington

Section I That there be and is hereby established an improvement district within the limits of the Town of Yacolt, Clarke County, Washington to be called Local Improvement District No. 4, which shall be bounded by the following mentioned lines and shall embrace all the property included in the following description: <sup>to wit:</sup>

Beginning at a point on the North side of Block 1 of first addition to Yacolt, 90 feet west of the West line of West
