An Ordinance amending Section 2 of
Ordinance No 16 entitled "an Ordinance
in Relation to licenses and punishment
for the violation of the terms thereof"
and repealing Ordinance No 52, entitled an ordinance amending Ordinance
No 16 entitled "an ordinance in relation to licenses and punishment for the
violation of the terms thereof"
The Town Council of the Town of
Yacolt, Washington ordains as
follows:-

Section 1- That Section 2 of Ordinance No
16 entitled "An Ordinance in Relation to licenses
and punishment for the violation of the
terms thereof" be amended to read as
follows: Section 2. The owner of any
stage, carriage, coach, automobile truck
hack, dray, cart or wagon or other vehicle
which shall be used for the conveyance
of passengers, ^{Packages} goods or freight of any
kind within the town limits, for
hire, (except hand carts and vehicles used
by merchants, dealers and manufacturers
exclusively for the delivery of their
wares to their customers and the
vehicles of livery stables and hotels)
shall pay a quarterly license to-wit:
All vehicles drawn by one horse the sum
of \$1.00 per quarter; all vehicles drawn
by two horses the sum of \$2.00 per
quarter and automobile trucks the sum
of \$2.00 per quarter for each vehicle so
used. The owner or keeper of such vehicle
licensed under the provisions of this
ordinance shall provide a metal
plate three (3) inches wide and six (6) inches
long upon which shall be printed in
conspicuous figures the number of the

license issued therefor, and said plate shall be affixed to said licensed vehicle in some conspicuous part thereof.

Section 2 - Ordinance No 52, bring an ordinance amending Ordinance No 16 entitled "an ordinance in relation to licenses and ^{penalties for} the violation of the terms thereof" is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall upon its passage by the Council, approval by the mayor and publishing as required by law, be in full force and effect from and after April 1, 1918

An Ordinance prohibiting the sale or explosion of fireworks in the Town of Yacolt, Washington, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof

Be it Ordained by the Town Council of Yacolt, Washington:

Section I It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm or Corporation to sell or offer for sale, to keep or to store any firecrackers, roman-candles, pinwheels, skyrockete, sparklers or any fireworks or explosives of any description whatsoever, excepting ammunition for fire arms, in the Town of Yacolt, Washington.

Section II It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, firm or Corporation to explode or cause to explode, ignite or cause to be ignited any fire-crackers, roman-candles, pinwheels, skyrockete, sparklers or any fireworks or explosives of any description whatsoever in the Town of Yacolt, Washington, excepting by special permit from the Town Council.

Section III. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed so as to interfere with the signal service of the Railway Companies, where torpedos and fuses are used
