

Section IV Any person or persons, firm or Corporation who shall be found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding \$30.00 or by imprisonment of not more than ten days or both.

Section V This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town Council, approval by the Mayor and publication as required by law.

An Ordinance amending the fourth section of Ordinance No 45 entitled "An Ordinance empowering the Mayor of the town of Yakolt to appoint an Attorney, Poundmaster, Superintendent of Streets, Civil Engineer, Police Justice, Police Officers, a Health Officer, Marshall and Clerk; to report such appointments of said officers to the Town Council; to fix the Salaries or compensations; to provide for bonds for all or any of said appointed or elective officers; and to provide any other regulations of all or any of the said officers as may be deemed necessary by the Mayor and Council" and to repeal Ordinance No 62 passed by the town Council, February 7, 1917.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the town of Yakolt, Washington as follows:

That the fourth section of Ordinance No 45, entitled "An Ordinance empowering the Mayor of the town of Yakolt to appoint an Attorney, Poundmaster, Superintendent of Streets, Civil Engineer, Police Justice, Police Officers, a Health Officer, Marshall and Clerk; to report such appointments of said officers to the town Council; to fix the salaries and compensations of such officers as well to receive salaries or compensations; to provide for bonds for all of said appointed or elective officers and to provide any other regulations of all or any of the said officers as may

be deemed necessary by the Mayor and Council" be amended and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Fourth: The following mentioned officers shall receive for their services the following named amounts to-wit:

The clerk the sum of \$10⁰⁰ per month

The Marshall the sum of \$30⁰⁰ per month, of which \$25⁰⁰ per month shall be paid out of the Current Expense Fund and \$5⁰⁰ per month out of the water fund.

The Attorney the sum of \$ _____ per month

The Civil Engineer the sum of \$ _____ per month

The Health Officer the sum of \$ _____ per month

The Superintendent of Streets the sum of \$ _____ per month

The Police Justice the sum of \$ _____ per trial.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the town council and publication according to law.
