An ordinance to license and regulate pool halls, card rooms, billiard halls and soft drink establishments in the town of Yacolt, Clarke County, Washington, limiting the rights of minors there-in and prescribing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the town of Yacolt, Washington:

Section I

That any person or persons who shall hereafter desire to open or maintain any public pool or billiard hall or card room or hall, or who shall ^{open or} maintain any establishment where soft drinks are offered for sale, shall first make application to the Town Council for a license therefor, and if the said town council shall by resolution grant such license, such person or persons so licensed shall pay a quarterly license fee of \$1.00.

Section II

Whenever such license shall be ordered issued and the fee paid, the Town Clerk shall issue to such person or persons a license which shall recite in substance that such license has been granted to such person or persons for such purpose as the same may have been granted, which license shall be signed by the Town Clerk and shall be effective to license such person or persons for a period of three months.

Section III

The expression "pool hall, billiard hall or card room" shall be construed to mean any place open to the public where pool or billiard tables or card tables are maintained for the entertain-

ment of the public and which is frequented by the public generally.

The expression, "soft drink establishment" shall be construed to mean any public place where soft drinks are offered for sale to the public.

Section IV

Any establishment licensed under the provisions of this ordinance shall not remain open after the hour of 11 P. M.

Section V

No person or persons holding a license under the provisions hereof shall sell or offer for sale or give away, any tobacco, cigars or cigarettes to any person under the age of 18 years, unless the said person present an order for the same signed by the parent or guardian of such minor.

Section VI

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 18 years to frequent any of the places described herein or to play at the games therein maintained, and any person holding a license under the provisions of this Ordinance or operating such places as are described herein or any employee there-in, who shall permit any minor under the age of 18 years to frequent or to play games maintained there-in shall be guilty of misdemeanor, provided, however that the restrictions here-in shall apply only to pool and billiard hall and card rooms and not to soft drink establishments otherwise legitimately maintained.

Section VII

The town Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington shall have full and complete power to issue or refuse any license applied for under the provisions

of this Ordinance and after such license is issued, the Town Council retains the right, upon proper cause to cancel and revoke such license forthwith.

Section VIII.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be judged guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or shall be imprisoned not to exceed thirty days (30 days).

Ordinance No 69.

An ordinance providing for and ordering the improvement of certain portions of Yacolt Road street, Hubbard street and Jones street in the town of Yacolt, Washington, establishing the grade of said streets and adopting plans and specifications for such improvement and providing for payment of costs of said improvement by special assessment levied upon property within an improvement district established here-in known as "Improvement District No 5."

Be it ordered by the Town Council of Yacolt:

Section I

That Yacolt Road street shall be improved with a twenty-six (26) foot grade and surface gravelling from the West line of Hubbard street eastward to the Town limits.

Section II

That Hubbard street in said town shall be improved from the South line of Yacolt Road street to the North line of Jones street by grading to a width of thirty (30) feet and surface gravelling.

Section III

That Jones street in said town shall be improved from the point of intersection of said street with the rail-way tracks, of the Northern Pacific Rail-way Company eastward to the town limits with a thirty-six (36) foot grade, surface gravelling and also necessary bridge or culvert to bring the low spots up to

Section IV

All of said work shall be done in strict compliance with plans and specifications therefore
