of this Ordinance and after such license is issued, the Town Council retains the right, upon proper cause to cancel and revoke such license forthwith.

## Section VIII.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be judged guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or shall be imprisoned not to exceed thirty days (30 days).

## Ordinance No 69.

An ordinance providing for and ordering the improvement of certain portions of Yacolt Road street, Hubbard street and Jones street in the town of Yacolt, Washington, establishing the grade of said streets and adopting plans and specifications for such improvement and providing for payment of costs of said improvement by special assessment levied upon property within an improvement district established here-in known as "Improvement District No 5."

Be it ordered by the Town Council of Yacolt:

## Section I

That Yacolt Road street shall be improved with a twenty-six (26) foot grade and surface gravelling from the West line of Hubbard street eastward to the Town limits.

## Section II

That Hubbard street in said town shall be improved from the South line of Yacolt Road street to the North line of Jones street by grading to a width of thirty (30) feet and surface gravelling.

## Section III

That Jones street in said town shall be improved from the point of intersection of said street with the rail-way tracks, of the Northern Pacific Rail-way Company eastward to the town limits with a thirty-six (36) foot grade, surface gravelling and also necessary bridge or culvert to bring the low spots up to

All of said work shall be done in strict compliance with plans and specifications therefore

which have been prepared by the Town Engineer and on file with the Town Clerk, all of which plans and specifications referred to are hereby adopted for the improvement above directed.

## Section V

That the Town Engineer has filed herein a proposed grade for the said streets, all of which fully appears from maps, plats and field notes on file and the grades therein designated are hereby officially adopted as the grade for said streets within the limits of the improvement herein directed.

## Section VI

All of the costs and expenses of this improvement on each and all of the streets herein described shall be paid by a special assessment levied upon the property within an improvement district hereinafter to be described and designated, which assessment shall be hereafter levied on the property within said district in proportion to the benefits derived from said improvement.

## Section VII

That there is hereby established within the Town of Yacolt, State of Washington an improvement district to be known "Local Improvement District No 5" which district includes within its outlines all property especially benefitted upon which an assessment is to be levied to pay the costs of the improvement above ordered and which Improvement District is outlined as follows:

Commencing at the South East corner of Lot twenty-one (21) of First Addition to Yacolt Acre Tracts, as per official plat there of on file in the office of the County Auditor of Clarke County, Washington; and running thence North 1098.4 feet to the North side of Yacolt Road street in the Town of Yacolt, Washington; thence North 100 feet; thence West 1368.4 feet; thence South 160 feet; thence West 150 feet; thence South 465 feet; thence West 391 feet; thence South East 360 feet; thence East 390 feet; thence South 209.8 feet to the South line of Lot Thirty (30) of said First Addition to Yacolt Acre Tracts, and thence East 1300 feet to the point of beginning.

## Section VIII

The Town Engineer is hereby directed to prepare and return herein an assessment roll which shall be done as soon as the total costs of the improvement shall have been ascertained, which assessment roll shall assess the costs of said improvement in the manner as provided by law and after being prepared shall be returned and filed with the Clerk.

## Section IX

This work shall be done by contract and the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of a call for bids for the making of this improvement, which notice shall state the time and place where the bids shall be opened and said notice shall be given by posting the same in three (3) public places in Yacolt, Washington, and the same at least once in a newspaper published weekly and of general circulation in Clarke County Wash.

## Section X

There is no newspaper published within the Town of Yacolt, Washington, and this Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and posting as provided by law.

## Ordinance No. 70.

An Ordinance approving and confirming the Assessment Roll of Property in Local Improvement District No. 5 of the town of Yacolt, Wash. for the payment of the improvement of Yacolt Road Street, Hubbard Street and Jones Street east of the Northern Pacific Rail-road Company's right of way and providing for the payment of said assessment.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington

That heretofore the Town Council passed an ordinance for the improvement of Yacolt Road Street, Hubbard Street and Jones Street east of the Northern Pacific Rail-road Company's right of way in the said town of Yacolt within certain limits in said ordinance set forth, and creating Local Improvement District No. 5 the property within the said district to bear the cost of the said improvement. That thereafter on the 7th day of August 1922 the town Engineer as provided by Law and Ordinance of the Town of Yacolt, Washington filed with the Town Clerk, his assessment roll showing the amount of the costs of the said improvement to be borne by each lot tract or parcel of land within the said improvement district. That thereafter the Town Council, by motion, set the 18th. day of September 1922 at the hour of 8 o'clock P. M. as the date for hearing on the said
