

Ordinance No. 78.

An Ordinance repealing Ordinances Nos. 10, 12, 16 and 68 of the Town of Yacolt.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington:

Section I

That Ordinance No. 10 of the Town of Yacolt Washington, entitled: "An Ordinance governing children under 18 years of age, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof" be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section II

That Ordinance No. 12 of the Town of Yacolt Washington, entitled: "To license, tax, regulate and restrain the keeping of dogs within the Town limits," be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section III

That Ordinance No. 16 of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, entitled: "An ordinance in relation to licenses and punishment for the violation of the terms thereof," be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section IV

That Ordinance No. 68 of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, entitled: "An Ordinance to license and regulate pool halls, card rooms, billiard halls and soft drink establishments in the Town of Yacolt, Clark County, Washington, limiting the rights of minors therein and prescribing a penalty for the violation thereof," be and the same is hereby repealed.

This ordinance to take effect 5 days from and after the date of its publication or posting
