Ordinance No. 79.

An Ordinance amending Section IV of Ordinance 66 of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, entitled: "An Ordinance empowering the Mayor of the Town of Yacolt to appoint an Attorney, Townmaster, a Superintendent of Streets, Civil Engineer, Police Justice, Police Officers, a Health Officer, Marshal and Clerk, to report such appointments of said officers to the Town Council, to fix the salaries or compensations; to provide for bonds for all or any of said appointed or elective officers; and to provide any other regulations of all or any of the said officers as may be deemed necessary by the Mayor and Council, and to repeal Ordinance No. 62 passed by the Town Council February 7, 1917."

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington:

Section I

That Section IV of Ordinance No. 66, as above entitled, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section IV. The following mentioned officers shall receive for their services the following named amounts, to-wit:

- The Clerk, the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars per month.
- The Marshal, the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per month.
- The Attorney, the sum of — Dollars per month.
- The Civil Engineer, the sum of — Dollars per month.
- The Health Officer, the sum of — Dollars per month.
- The Superintendent of Streets, the sum of — Dollars per month.
- The Police Justice, the sum of — Dollars per trial.

Section III

This Ordinance to take effect five (5) days from and after the date of its publication

or posting.
