Ordinance No. 87.

An Ordinance providing for the licensing of lawful games of skill for revenue purposes and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Town of Yakolt, Washington, as follows:

Section I.

That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to own, maintain, keep, operate or offer for public use or play any marble game, pin game or other lawful device or machine designed to test the skill of a player, until and unless the owner or operator of such game, device or machine shall have applied for and secured a license as provided in the following section.

Section II.

The license herein provided shall be issued by the Town Clerk upon application therefor and the payment of the sum of \$2.00 per month for each game device or machine, and shall expire at midnight on the last day of the month for which payment is made and license issued and shall state the month and year for which issued and shall bear the official seal of the town and the name of the Town Clerk, and shall be posted or securely fixed in a conspicuous place on the game, device or machine so licensed, and shall not be transferred to any other game or device for which a license may be payable.

Section III.

The violation of the above provision shall be punished by the payment of a fine of not more than \$100.00. Each day in which a game, device or machine is operated in violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate and distinct offense and be punishable as such.

Section IV.

This Ordinance shall become effective on and after the first day of June, 1936
