An Ordinance providing for the licensing for revenue purposes of pool tables, billiard tables, card tables and any stand or fixture upon which or wherein any game of any kind is played or carried on in any manner in any public resort and fixing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, as follows:

Section I.

That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to own, keep, maintain, operate or offer for use in any public resort within the Town of Yacolt any pool table, billiard table, card table or any stand or fixture upon which or wherein any game of any kind is played or carried on, without first having procured and having in full force and effect a license authorizing him so to do.

Section II.

That the license herein provided for shall be issued by the Town Clerk upon application therefor and the payment of the sum of \$1.00 per quarter for each pool table, billiard table, card table or other stand or fixture upon which or wherein any game of any kind is played or carried on in any manner in any resort. Said license shall expire upon the last day of March, June, September or December of the quarter for which the same was issued. The license shall state the period for which the same is issued and shall bear the official seal of the town and the name of the Town Clerk and shall be displayed conspicuously in the room or building in which the table stand or fixture is situated and shall, as far as possible, identify or describe the table, stand or fixture covered by said license.

Section III.

The violation of the above provision shall be punished by the payment of a fine of not more than \$100.00. Each day in which a game, device or machine is operated in violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate and distinct offense and be punishable as such.
