

Ordinance No. 89.

An ordinance repealing Section 2 of Ordinance No. 80 and amending Section 30 of Ordinance 67, entitled; "An Ordinance to regulate the management of the water works of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, specify the price to be charged, designate the collection of the water rents and the proper Committee of the Council to handle the business and other particulars regarding the government of the water systems of Yacolt."

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, as follows:

Section I.

That Section 2 of Ordinance #80 entitled: "An ordinance relating to the regulation and management of the water works of the Town of Yacolt" be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section II.

That Section 30 of Ordinance #67, entitled: "An Ordinance amending Section 30 of Ordinance #31" be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section xxx. The following rates are prescribed as the monthly water rates of the Town of Yacolt, said rates payable in advance within the first ten days of each month:

Barber Shop	.50
Restaurant	.50
Office Building	.50
Office & Bank	.50
Blacksmith & Garage	.50
School	1.00
Church	0.00

Residences	.50
Meat Markets	.50
Private Barn (two head of stock or less)	.50
Each extra two head	.25
