

Ordinance No. 91.

An Ordinance closing and vacating that portion of Wilson Avenue in the Town of Yacolt, from the East line of the Northern Pacific Right-of-way to the West line of Hubbard Street in said town and vacating that plot of ground bounded on the North by Humphrey Street, on the East by Hubbard Street and on the South-West by the Northern Pacific Right-of-way in said town.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt:

That pursuant to a petition heretofore filed containing the names of all of the owners of property abutting upon that portion of Wilson Avenue from the East line of the Northern Pacific Right-of-way to the West line of Hubbard Street and that plot of ground bounded on the North by Humphrey Street, on the East by Hubbard Street and on the South-West by the Northern Pacific Right-of-way, a Resolution was adopted fixing Monday, April 7, 1941, at 8:00 P.M. as the time for hearing said petition; that notices thereof was given in the manner and for the time required by law, and it appearing at said hearing that said street should be closed and vacated and said plot of ground be vacated,

Now, Therefore, It Is Hereby Ordered that that portion of Wilson Avenue in the Town of Yacolt, from the East line of the Northern Pacific Right-of-way to the West line of Hubbard Street be, and the same is hereby vacated and closed, and the plot of ground bounded on the North by Humphrey Street, on the East by Hubbard Street and on the South-West by the Northern Pacific Right-of-way be, and the same is hereby vacated.
