

Ordinance No. 92.

An ordinance empowering the Mayor of the Town of Macoll to appoint an attorney, Poundmaster, a Superintendent of Streets, Civil Engineer, Police Justice, Police Officers, a Health Officer Marshall and Clerk; to report such appointments to the Town Council; to fix the salaries and compensations as such officers as are to receive salaries or compensations; to provide for bonds for all or any of said appointed or elective officers; and to provide any other regulations of all or any of the said officers as may be deemed necessary by the Mayor and Council and to repeal Ordinance No. 45 and 85 previously passed by the Town Council.

It is ordained by the Council of the Town of Macoll as follows, to-wit:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the Town of Macoll shall appoint the following officers for said Town, to-wit: an Attorney, Poundmaster, Superintendent of Streets, a Civil Engineer and such Police and other subordinate officers deemed necessary.

Section 2: Any vacancies occurring in any of the offices provided for in Section 1, occurring either by death, resignation or removal by the Mayor, shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, such appointment to be duly reported to the Council at the next meeting of the same.

Section 3: All of the officers mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance shall receive such compensation for their services as such officers as may be determined by the Council, in this ordinance hereinafter mentioned, provided always that the Council shall keep intact any contract for a definite time already made.

Section IV: The following mentioned officers shall receive for their services the following named amounts, to-wit:

- > The Clerk the sum of \$10.00 per month; ~~repealed by ord. 94~~
- > The Treasurer the sum of \$10.00 per month;
- > The Marshall the sum of \$15.00 per month;
- The Attorney the sum of \$ — per month;
- The Health Officer the sum of \$ — per month;
- The Supt. of Streets the sum of \$ — per month;
- The Police Justice the sum of \$ — per month.

Section V: The following mentioned officers before beginning the performance of their duties, shall enter into a surety bond to the Town of Macoll for the proper performance of their duties, the expense of the execution of said bond to be paid out of the Current Expense Fund of Macoll, as follows, to-wit:

- The Treasurer in the sum of \$3000.00,
- The Clerk in the sum of \$500.00,
- The Marshall in the sum of \$500.00,
- The Attorney in the sum of \$ —
- The Health Officer in the sum of \$ —
- The Supt. of Streets in the sum of \$ —
- The Police Justice in the sum of \$ — ?

Section VI: The Health Officer shall not incur any expense in the caring for sick and in his performance of duty as such Health Officer, chargeable to the Town of Macoll, without first having an order to take care of such sick or injured person, and having been previously empowered by the Mayor to so care for such person and make such expenditures.

~~Section III: This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage by the Town Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.~~

~~An Ordinance providing for reimbursement for expenses and for payment of salaries to the Mayor and Councilmen of the Town of Yacolt, and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.~~

~~Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt:~~

~~Section I: That the Mayor and members of the Council of the Town of Yacolt shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the discharge of their official duties, upon presentation of a claim therefor, and after allowance of and approval of the same, by resolution of the Town Council.~~

~~Section II: That the Mayor and Councilmen shall severally receive as salary, the sum of One Dollar and Fifty Cents per meeting for not more than two council meetings each month, and that payment thereof shall commence when each of said officials shall be qualified to receive the same under the applicable law.~~

~~Section III: That all salaries shall be paid out of the Current Expense Fund of said Town of Yacolt.~~

~~Section IV: That this ordinance is enacted under the provisions of Chapter 115 of the 1941 Session Laws of the State of Washington.~~

~~Section V: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and they are, hereby repealed.~~

~~Section VI: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication.~~
