~~An Ordinance providing for reimbursement for expenses and for payment of salaries to the Mayor and Councilmen of the Town of Yacolt, and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.~~

~~Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt:~~

~~Section I: That the Mayor and members of the Council of the Town of Yacolt shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the discharge of their official duties, upon presentation of a claim therefor, and after allowance of and approval of the same, by resolution of the Town Council.~~

~~Section II: That the Mayor and Councilmen shall severally receive as salary, the sum of One Dollar and Fifty Cents per meeting for not more than two council meetings each month, and that payment thereof shall commence when each of said officials shall be qualified to receive the same under the applicable law.~~

~~Section III: That all salaries shall be paid out of the Current Expense Fund of said Town of Yacolt.~~

~~Section IV: That this ordinance is enacted under the provisions of Chapter 115 of the 1941 Session Laws of the State of Washington.~~

~~Section V: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and they are, hereby repealed.~~

~~Section VI: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication.~~

Ordinance #94.

An Ordinance vacating a portion of Ankeny Street in the Town of Yacolt, Washington, and providing for the restoration thereof to the owners of the abutting property.

Be It Ordained By The Town Council of The Town of Yacolt, Washington:

Section 1: That Whereas, heretofore, certain property owners in the Town of Yacolt, Washington, filed with the town clerk their petition asking for the vacation of Ankeny Street therein. And Whereas, the Council, by proper resolution, set the date of May 18, 1942, at 8:00 P.M. for the hearing of said petition, and Whereas, it appears that proper notice was given by posting as provided by law:

That Ankeny Street as the same lies between Blocks numbered Three and Four (3 and 4) of the Second Addition to Yacolt and extending from the North line of Jones Street to the South line of Cushman Street in the said Town of Yacolt, be, and the same is hereby vacated and all the rights of the Town of Yacolt therein, are hereby granted and ceded to the owners of the abutting property, abutting on the said vacated portion of Ankeny Street as provided by law.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and five days after the posting thereof as provided by law.
