

Ordinance No. 101

An Ordinance relating to Public Health, declaring an emergency and appropriating money by reason thereof.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington;

Section I

The Yacolt City Park has no toilets or other sanitary protection, and said park will be used by the public generally in the coming warm weather and by reason thereof create danger to the public health because of lack of sanitation.

Section II

By reason of the foregoing facts an emergency is found to exist and an emergency is hereby declared to exist.

Section III

The estimated cost of meeting said emergency is the sum of \$250.00 and said sum of \$250.00 is hereby appropriated from the Current Expense Fund to meet said emergency and said \$250.00 is here by transferred to the Health and Sanitation fund.

Ordinance No. 102

An Ordinance relating to street improvement, declaring an emergency and appropriating money by reason thereof.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Town of Yacolt,

I

The Yacolt streets being in such condition as to be unsafe, and as no money is available in the Street Fund, and by reason thereof create danger to the public in general unless repaired.

II

By reason of the foregoing facts an emergency is found to exist and an emergency is hereby declared to exist

III

The estimated cost of meeting said emergency is the sum of \$3,402.00, the sum of \$2,407.00 to be granted by the Washington State Development Board and the sum of \$1,205.00 is here by appropriated from the Current Expense Fund to meet said emergency and the sum of \$1,205.00 is hereby transferred to the Washington State Development Board Street Fund.
