

## Ordinance No. 103.

An ordinance relating to public safety and to prohibit the parking of any motor vehicle within 15 feet from each corner of block 1 which is bordered on the north by Ascolt Road Street, on the east by Railroad Street, on the south by Cushman Street and on the west by parcel street in the Town of Ascolt Washington, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it enacted by the Council of the Town of Ascolt, Washington as follows.

I

It is hereby declared a menace to Public safety by reason of obscured vision to have any motor vehicle parked on the corners of Block 1 which is bordered on the north by Ascolt Road Street, on the east by Railroad Street, on the south by Cushman Street and on the west by Parcel Street

Therefore be it enacted by the Town Council that no motor vehicle shall park within 15 feet of each corner of said block in the town of Ascolt Washington

II

Any person found guilty of violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined the sum of \$2.50 for first offence \$5.00 for second offence and double the amount thereafter.

III

This ordinance will be in full force and effect when it shall have been passed by the Council, signed by the mayor, attested by the clerk and duly posted as provided by law.
