

Ordinance No. 105

An Ordinance relating to Street Maintenance, declaring an emergency and appropriating money by reason thereof.

Be it ordained by the Council of the town of Jacolt as follows:

I
The Jacolt streets being in such condition as to be unsafe and as not enough money is available in the street fund for the maintenance of same in a satisfactory manner without the aid of a power grader - by reason of the foregoing facts an emergency is found to exist and an emergency is hereby declared to exist -

The estimated cost of meeting said emergency is the sum of \$1500.00 and the sum of \$1000.00 is hereby transferred from the water fund to the City Street Fund -
