Ordinance No-107

An Ordinance providing for holding
caucuses, preparing ballots, and giving notice
of Elections.

Be it Ordained by the Council of Spacolt,
Washington:

Section I

That there shall be held in the said Town
a caucus for the purpose of accepting
nominations for offices which expire 1st Monday
in June.

Such caucuses shall be called by the Mayor
at least ten days prior to such Election and held
at least six days prior to said Election.

Section II

This Caucus to be called to order by the
Mayor and presided over by a Chairman
to be elected by the voters assembled.

The Chairman shall appoint a secretary
and vote tellers

Section III

Then the Chairman shall call for verbal
nominations for offices to be filled.

Thereupon the caucus shall proceed to make
written ballots on nominations made and
the nominee receiving the greatest number
of votes shall be placed on the ballot.

Section IV

That any other group of citizens may
hold a caucus and nominate a ticket of any
offices or officers to be elected.

Section V

All such tickets shall be given a name.

Section VI

All tickets shall be certified to the Town
Clerk at least five days prior to the time

of holding such election, such Certificate
to be signed by the Chairman and Secretary
of the meeting making the nomination.

Section VII

at such caucus, only duly qualified electors
of the Town of Spacolt shall participate, namely,
only those persons registered and duly qualified
to vote within the Town of Spacolt, and residing
within said Town.

Section VIII

all tickets shall be printed upon one ballot,
which shall be prepared in sufficient number
to provide one for each voter of said Town

Section IX

Any person shall have the right to withdraw
their names from any tickets at any time
prior to the time the ballot is printed, and
such event the clerk shall omit his or her name
from the ballot; such request may be made
by written request filed with the Town Clerk.

Section X

notice of any Election may be given by
the Mayor and Clerk by posting notices of
holding such Election in at least three
public places in said Town.
