

Section ~~III~~ XI

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment for not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day of continued violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense hereunder.

Section XII

If any section, paragraph, or portion of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such ruling shall not affect the remaining items, parts, or provisions of this Ordinance.

Section XIII

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section XIV

out { The Town Council reserves the right to change the fee of licenses at any time by resolution.

Ordinance No. 114

An Ordinance relating to street maintenance, declaring an emergency and appropriating money by reason thereof;

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt as follows:

Section I

The Yacolt streets being in such condition as to be unsafe and not enough money having been budgeted for the maintenance of same in a satisfactory manner, an emergency is found to exist and an emergency is hereby declared to exist.

Section II

The estimated amount to meet this emergency is \$1000.00 and that part of the Budget pertaining to the Street Maintenance fund is hereby increased \$1,000.00.
