

Ordinance No. 115

An Ordinance amending section III of Ordinance No. 113 Entitled an Ordinance relating to and providing for a License fee or Occupational tax upon businesses, occupational pursuits and privileges, defining offenses and providing penalties.

Be it ordained by the Town Council -

Sec. III of Ordinance No. 113 shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. I

There is hereby levied and shall be collected an annual license fee or occupational tax against every person engaged in lawful business in the Town of Yacolt, Washington, as defined below, in the sum of \$12.00 per annum. The license fees or taxes set forth in this ordinance shall be for the calendar year, and each person engaged in business must pay the full license either for the current year or balance thereof during which year or portion thereof he had engaged in business. Every license issued hereunder shall expire on December 31st next following the date of its issue.

Sec. II

In this ordinance any person engaged in a business who holds a State of Washington Tax Stamp or any person engaged in rentals, renting two or more houses or units, shall be required to pay this fee or tax. Any person holding such business license shall not be required to pay an additional tax for any other business engaged in.

Sec. III

This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage by the Town Council & Posting according to law.

Ordinance No. 116

An Ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 88, Entitled, "An Ordinance providing for the licensing for revenue purposes of pool tables, billiard tables, card tables and any stand or fixture upon which or whereon any game of any kind is played or carried on in any manner in any public resort and fixing a penalty for the violation thereof," and repealing Ordinance No. 87, Entitled, "An ordinance providing for the licensing of lawful games of skill for revenue purposes and providing a penalty for the violation thereof;" and repealing Ordinances Numbers 90, 97 and 104, which amend Ordinances 87 and 88.

And an Ordinance providing for the licensing for revenue purposes of Cabarets, Nickelodeons, pool tables, billiard tables, card tables, shuffleboard tables, and any stand or fixture upon which or within which any game of any kind is played or carried on in any manner in any public resort and fixing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be It Ordained By The Town Council Of The Town Of Yacolt Washington

Section I

That the licenses herein provided for shall be issued by the town clerk upon application thereof and the payment of fees as set forth in Section 2, except that an application for Cabaret License shall be approved by the Town Council before a license is issued by the Clerk.

Section II

The following fees shall be paid to the Clerk to obtain these licenses:

- \$1.00 (One dollar) per month for each pool table
\$1.00 (One dollar) per month for each card table
\$1.00 (One dollar) per month for each shuffleboard table
\$5.00 (Five dollars) per month for each Nickelodeon
\$10.00 (Ten dollars) per month for license to operate a Cabaret.

Ordinance No. 116 Cont'd.

Section III

The license shall state the period for which same is issued, and shall bear the name of the Town Clerk, and the Official Seal of the Town, and shall be displayed conspicuously in the room or building in which it is used.

Section IV

The violation of the above provision shall be punished by the payment of a fine of not more than \$100.00. Each day in which this Ordinance is violated constitutes a separate and distinct offence and shall be punishable as such.

Section V

This Ordinance shall be in effect from ^{and} after its passage by the Town Council, and five days after the posting thereof as provided by law.

Ordinance No. 117.

An Ordinance establishing traffic regulations in the Town of Yacolt and providing penalties for the violation thereof -

Be It Ordained By The Town Council Of The Town Of Yacolt, Washington.

Sec. I

That the Washington State Statutes relating to traffic and Motor Vehicles be adopted by reference.

Sec. II

That any amendments to, or any changes in the Washington State Statutes relating to traffic and Motor Vehicles shall automatically become part of this ordinance without further action of the Council.

Sec. III

That three copies of the Washington State Statutes relating to traffic and Motor Vehicles be kept in the office of the City Clerk for reference by the people of the Town of Yacolt.

Sec. IV

This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage by the Town Council, and five days after the posting thereof as provided by law.
