ORDINANCE NO 118

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE WATER DEPARTMENT FUND AND THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND APPROPRIATING MONEY BY REASON THEREOF:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

DUE TO THE UNUSUALLY LARGE MAINTAINANCE EXPENSE IN THE WATER DEPARTMENT AND NOT ENOUGH MONEY HAVING BEEN BUDGETED FOR THE PAY-MENT OF SAME, AN EMERGENCY IS FOUND TO EXIST AND AN EMERGENCY IS HEREBY DECLARED TO EXIST.

SECTION II

THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT TO MEET THIS EMERGENCY IS \$1,000 AND THAT PART OF THE BUDGET PERTAINING TO THE WATER DEPARTMENT FUND IS HEREBY INCREASED \$1,000.

SECTION III

THAT PART OF THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND PERTAINING TO DEPART-MENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIES SHALL HEREBY BE INCREASED \$25.00 TO PAY INDUSTRIAL INSURANCE ON THE ADDITIONAL LABOR REQUIRED BY THE WATER DEPARTMENT.

SECTION IV

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE AFTER IT'S PASSAGE BY THE TOWN COUNCIL AND POSTING AS ACCORDING TO LAW --
