

An Ordinance relating to the 1958 Budget: declaring an emergency and appropriating money by reason therefore:

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YACOLT DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Due to the under-estimates in the 1958 Budget as to the amount of money needed for extra supplies for the office and under-estimate for the Bookmobile Service in the Current Expense Fund: and mileage and safe deposit box in the Water Department; and Industrial Insurance in the Street Department; an emergency is found to exist and an emergency is hereby declared to exist.

SECTION 2.

To meet the emergency the following changes are hereby made in the 1958 Budget:

1. The amount budgeted for Treasurer's expense in the Current Expense Fund is increased \$24.00 To \$74.00.
2. The amount budgeted for the Bookmobile service in the Current Expense Fund is increased \$9.00 to \$ 221.07.
3. The amount budgeted for mileage in the Water Department is increased \$22.00 to \$137.00.
4. The amount budgeted for the safe deposit box in the Water Department is increased \$3.00 to \$8.00.
5. The amount budgeted for Industrial Insurance and Medical Aid in the Street Department is increased \$1.50 to \$26.50.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage by the Town Council and five days after posting thereof as provided by law.
