NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, as follows:



MINISTERIAL CHANGES TO ORDINANCE #503


A 2016 review of Ordinances revealed that Ordinances #496 and #498, both addressing on-site sewage disposal systems, were passed by the Town on June 4, 2012. The Ordinances were substantively identical, but it appears that Ordinance #496 was a draft, and Ordinance #498 was a corrected copy of the Ordinance. Ordinance #496 contained spacing errors that were corrected with Ordinance #498. A repeal of Ordinance #496 is forthcoming, and ministerial changes are being approved to page 10 of Ordinance #498.

A reference in Ordinance #503 to Ordinance #496 was changed to Ordinance #498 to reflect the current, active, on-site sewage disposal system Ordinance.

A footer at the bottom of Ordinance #503 that previously read "Ordinance #" has been changed to read "Ordinance #503."




