

An Ordinance of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, specifying and adopting a plan for the acquisition, construction and installation of certain additions and improvements to and extensions of the water supply and distribution system of the town, declaring the estimated cost thereof, authorizing the issuance of water revenue bonds of the town in the principal sum of \$95,000 for the purpose of providing part of the funds necessary to acquire, construct, and install such additions, improvements and extensions, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the water supply and distribution system of the town is in need of certain additions, improvements and extensions in order to properly supply the town and its inhabitants with an adequate supply of potable water and with an adequate supply of water for fire protection purposes; and

WHEREAS, in order to pay part of the cost of such additions, improvements and extensions, it is deemed necessary that the town issue and sell its water revenue bonds in the principal sum of \$95,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, as follows;

Section 1. The following plan for the acquisition, construction and installation of additions and improvements to and extensions of the water supply and distribution system of the town is hereby specified and adopted, to wit:

The additions and betterments to the water system of the Town of Yacolt shall consist of the following:

A. Dam Revisions

The valving, screens and intake structure shall be revised to provide adequate screening of water.

B. Supply Line to Town System

An 8" water main shall be installed from the dam and reser-

voir to the east extension of Yacolt Road, Yacolt, Washington. The 8" line shall consist of 5,370 ft. of new steel pipe and 1,100 ft. of new 8" AC pipe. The AC pipe shall be furnished to the contractor by the Town of Yacolt.

C. Town Water System

The town water system shall consist of water mains, recon-  
nections to fire hydrants, reconnections to services and recon-  
nections to stand pipes. The lengths, sizes and locations of the main  
are as follows:

(1) Yacolt Road

Approximately 3,680 ft. of 8" main on the south  
side of Yacolt Road. From the supply main to  
Railroad Street; Approximately 415 ft. of 8"  
main on the north side of Yacolt Road from Rail-  
road Street to Parcell Street; Approximately  
1,157 ft. of 6" main on the north side of Yacolt Road.

(2) Johnson Street

Approximately 980 ft. of 6" main from Yacolt Road  
to Humphrey Street.

(3) Amboy Street

Approximately 200 ft. of 1" main north from Cush-  
man Street.

(4) Parcell Street

Approximately 1,340 ft. of 6" main from Yacolt Road  
to Wilson Avenue; Approximately 910 ft. of 4" main  
from Wilson Avenue to city limits.

(5) Railroad Street

Approximately 720 ft. of 4" main from Yacolt Road  
to Jones Street.

(6) Hubbard Street

Approximately 1,320 ft. of 6" main from Yacolt Road  
to Wilson Avenue.

(7) Road (not named)

Approximately 665 ft. of 6" main from Yacolt Road to Jones Street.

(8) Ankeny Street

Approximately 260 ft. of 2" main running east from Ankeny Street.

(9) Twins Falls Avenue

Approximately 260 ft. of 2" main running east from Ankeny Street.

(10) Cushman Street

Approximately 330 ft. of 4" main from Johnson Street to Blackmore Street; Approximately 1,130 ft. of 2" main from Blackmore Street to Railroad Street; Approximately 430 ft. of 2½" main east from Hubbard Street.

(11) Jones Street

Approximately 420 ft. of 4" main running east from Johnson Street; Approximately 730 ft. of 4" main from Parcell Street to Railroad Street; Approximately 280 ft. of 2½" main west from Hubbard; Approximately 1,350 ft. of 6" main from Hubbard Street to Road (not named).

(12) Humphrey Street

Approximately 700 ft. of 6" main from Johnson Street to Amboy Street; Approximately 750 ft. of 4" main from Parcell Street to Railroad Street; Approximately 250 ft. of 2½" main from Hubbard Street.

(13) Wilson Avenue

Approximately 1,280 ft. of 6" main from Parcell Street to Hubbard Street.

D; Water System Accessories

- (1) Chlorination Equipment

Chlorination equipment shall be installed in the supply main to assure safe water to consumers. Gas-type automatic chlorination equipment shall be used.

(2) A pressure reducing valve shall be installed in the supply main so that adequate pressure may be maintained in the water system.

(3) Pressure relief valve  
A pressure relief valve shall be installed in the town water system so that circulation of water may be maintained.

E. Property and Appurtenances

The aforesaid additions and improvements to and extensions of the water supply and distribution system of the town shall be connected one to the other and to the existing system so as to make a complete utility, and such additions, improvements and extensions shall be complete with all valves, fittings, saddles, and all other appurtenances required for the complete function thereof.

The town shall acquire all material and equipment, real or personal property, or interest therein, easements, franchises, and rights of way necessary to carry out the above-described plan.

It is hereby further provided that such plan shall be subject to such additions and changes as to detail or other changes not affecting the main general plans as hereinbefore set forth as may be authorized by the Town Council, either prior to or during the actual course of construction.

Section 2. The estimated cost of acquiring, constructing and installing such additions and improvements to and extensions of the water supply and distribution system of the town is hereby declared to be, as near as may be, the sum of \$101,000, which cost shall be provided from cash now in the Water System Construction Fund of the town and from the sale of water revenue bonds of the town in the principal sum of not to exceed \$95,000 .

, As an integral part of the plan for acquiring, constructing and installing such additions and improvements to and extensions of such water supply and distribution system, the town shall issue and sell such water revenue bonds in such amounts and at such time or times as the Town Council may determine to be to the best interests of the town. The exact date or dates, form, terms, maturities and covenants of such bonds shall be as hereafter fixed by ordinance or ordinances of the town.

Section 3. The action of the Town Council and town officials in calling for bids for the acquisition, construction and installation of the additions, improvements and extensions described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby in all respects ratified and confirmed.

Section 4 This ordinance is declared to be one necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of the people of the Town of Yacolt, Washington. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance is hereby declared to be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Passed by the Council of the Town of Yacolt, Washington, this 14th day of July, 1961, at a special meeting, notice of which was duly given as required by law.
